

**Washington Wolves Player
Standards for Player Conduct**

I fully understand that as a participant with the Washington Wolves Ice Hockey Club I am expected to:

- Attend all scheduled try-outs, practices, games and team meetings; arrive on time to meetings, practices and games; inform my captain or coach if I will be unable to attend a meeting, practice or game; participate in fund-raising activities unless excused from these requirements by my captain or coach;
- Follow the facility rules where we practice or participate in games;
- Participate actively in practices and games, treat my teammates, captain and coaches with consideration and respect, and endeavor to maintain a positive attitude toward the experience to the fullest extent possible;
- Communicate constructively with teammates and coaches about aspects of the hockey program and work with them in developing solutions to any problems I encounter;
- Remain mindful of the fact that as a representative of the Washington Wolves organization, my actions and words will significantly influence the reputation of my team, fellow players, and coaches within the broader arena of women's hockey;
- Refrain from actions that would impede my captain or coach from carrying out their responsibilities to the team, or places me, my fellow teammates, or coaches in danger of physical harm or expulsion from the league;
- Refrain from any behavior that violates USA Hockey rules or code of conduct, including intentional efforts to injure or verbally abuse other players, coaches, referees, bystanders; efforts to damage equipment or rink facilities; or actions that impede the ability of other players to participate in practices or games;
